The 2019 Audēre is comprised of our ultra premium Rockwell Ridge estate vineyard fruit (planted in 1993 at 1365 feet, 35 ft below the Howell Mountain AVA) in addition to Atlas Peak, and Pritchard Hill fruit.

2019 Growing Season	The beginning of the 2019 growing season was defined by copious rainfall early on, followed by long, warm summer days seeing foggy mornings, warm afternoons, and very few extreme heat events. The long mild finish to the season helped preserve freshness, bright acidity, and finesse in the fruit, extracting great color, structure, and rich tannins. 2019 is an amazing vintage delivering expressive wines of the highest quality, filled with vibrancy, silky textures, and enough rich opulence to cellar age for several decades.
